Agricultural Statistics Improvement Activity (ASIA) PASA	Under a recently amended PASA with USAID/Ethiopia, USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) is continuing to provide technical assistance to the Ethiopia Central Statistics Authority (CSA) in the implementation of the National Agricultural Census (NAC). This effort builds on previous work with both the CSA and the Ministry of Agriculture in the improvement of capability involved in data collection and information processing. A long-term NASS agricultural statistician resident advisor will be placed in Ethiopia for a two-year period. The advisor will provide technical assistance in the implementation of the NAC to include: reviewing results of the pilot census, analyzing results, determining sample size for primary and secondary sampling units; constructing sample frames, determining data collection procedures, developing and refining methodologies for crop yield forecast estimations. The resident advisor will also assist in the planning and conduct of the NAC and the analysis and dissemination of results. Funded by USAID and implemented by USDA/FAS. Commercialization Program	This program focuses on policies and regulations to promote commercialization and the transformation of agricultural technology into market-oriented and profitable products. Activities include natural products development and trade, food processing association development to enhance trade opportunities, and the use of information technology to increase agribusinesses' capacity to compete for markets and acquire technologies through the global marketplace. Funded by USAID and implemented by USDA/FAS.	Trade-Related Agriculture	39,783
Development of Competitive Markets	USAID is providing technical assistance and commodities, including computers and servers, to help the Ethiopian Ministry of Trade and Industry automate its trade registration and licensing system. Phase I included the development and testing of an application system was completed. Phase II includes the roll out of the application system and the purchase of computers and servers to Regional and Zonal offices, as well as limited expansion of the LAN at MOTI headquarters in Addis Ababa.
