Joint Coordinating Committee for Environmental Systems (JCCES)	In 1995, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and the Poland's Institute for the Ecology of Industrial Areas (IETU) signed the Agreement for Technical Exchange and Cooperation in the Area of Environmental Restoration and Hazardous Waste Management" to promote international scientific collaboration. The overall objective of this international partnership is to assist DOE in meeting its domestic environmental restoration and waste management goals. The Agreement is managed by the Joint Coordinating Committee for Environmental Systems (JCCES) which meets annually to assess program progress, review and approve proposals, evaluate potential future activities, share experiences, and develop innovative technologies jointly in two areas of environmental management, bioremediation and phytoremediation. JCCES membership consists of specialists from both countries who represent each technical area of cooperation. Through its collaboration with the Institute for International Cooperative Environmental Research (IICER) at Florida State University, the Department of Energy, Office of Environmental Management is able to access scientific and technical capabilities in Poland, Hungary, and the Czech Republic. The IICER maintains formal institution-to institution agreements of cooperation that link the IICER to the following institutions in the region: The Institute for the Ecology of Industrial Areas (IETU) Katowice, Poland; The Technical University of Budapest (TUB), Budapest, Hungary; and the Czech Technical University in Prague, Czech Republic.
