The second component is Business Training. In Tajikistan the SME Development project offers Customized Training and Open-enrollment Short Courses which consist of the courses on Preparing a Business Plan, Financial Statement Analysis, Human Resource Management and some other courses. The Customized Training schemes achieve maximum impact by providing specialized courses in topics that enhance the professional skills of all staff from top management down to line staff.
