Labor Dispute Resolution	This project aims to further Cambodia's economic and social progress by strengthening the country's labor dispute resolution system. Activities include: (1) Establishing a national dispute resolution system; (2) Training workers, employers and government officials to utilize the national dispute resolution system; (3) Developing a cadre of mediators and arbitrators to help resolve labor disputes; and (4) Creating a database to report on labor disputes and target preventive resources at problematic workplaces.
