Promoting Competitiveness of Guinean Products	This activity aims at promoting the competitiveness of Guinean agricultural products through the reduction of transaction costs and the improvement of product quality. Training will be provided to strengthen the capacity of the Guinean Ministries of Finance and Commerce in formulating and implementing sound fiscal, monetary and trade policies. This activity will contribute to the reduction of transaction costs through improved governance and favorable policy environment for regional and international trade. The competitiveness of agricultural products, including cashew nut, shea butter and honey, among others, will also be enhanced through technology transfer that improves not only the productivity of small scale private enterprises but also the quality of their products. In addition, trade capacity will be increased through technical assistance to increase the utility of market information systems for producers and traders. Funded and implemented by USAID/Guinea.
