<b>Caza of Byblos Solid Waste Management</b>	Despite ongoing efforts to improve waste disposal practices in the caza of Byblos, such as covering the waste with soil, exposure and public health risks continue at the Hbaline landfill site, which serves the city. This study will develop an integrated solid waste management system for the caza of Byblos that would be implemented on build-own-operate-transfer basis (BOOT). This financing mechanism would allow for greater job creations, thus further enhancing Byblos as one of Lebanon's premier tourist destinations as well as encouraging greater competition for the provision of solid waste services in Lebanon.
