Markets for Exports Expanded	This program will expand export markets by addressing "across the border" questions of market access, including negotiating markets, ensuring that requirements for access to particular markets are met (e.g. visa systems under Southern African Development Community (SADC), African Growth Opportunity Act (AGOA) and Everything But Arms (EBA), and providing necessary government technical support for standards (Sanitary and Phytosanitary - SPS, Agricultural Plant Health Inspection Service - APHIS, etc.). This activity will also assist the government to reduce its dependence on trade taxes, establish sensible overall customs legislation that is compliant with World Trade Organization (WTO) requirements, open the economy further, and ensure good coordination of trade policy across ministries.
