The advisor works with member countries' counterparts (Angola, Botswana, Lesotho, Malawi, Mauritius, Mozambique, South Africa, Swaziland, Tanzania, Zambia and Zimbabwe) on all phases of the USDA/Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) agricultural Pest Risk Assessment process in order to increase their capacities to trade agricultural goods within the region and internationally.
