Southern Sudan Agriculture Revitalization Program (Technical Support)	The Southern Sudan Agriculture Revitalization Program (SSARP) is a five-year, \$22.5 million initiative to increase capacity for agricultural production and marketing in southern Sudan. The SSARP Technical Support Component is implemented by the US Department of Agriculture through a Participating Agency Service Agreement with USAID. Among other activities, the Technical Support Component assists commodity networks (made up of southern Sudanese producer groups) to improve quality and increase their capacity for export. Sudan Transitional Assistance for Rehabilitation (STAR)	The Sudan Transitional Assistance for Rehabilitation (STAR) Program seeks to improve local capacity for economic rehabilitation in southern Sudan. The Strategic Analysis-Capacity Building component, implemented through USAID with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, seeks to build the capacity of seven working groups of southern Sudanese professionals undertaking research and policy analysis associated with agriculture and natural resources management. One of the working groups is focused on the Legal and Institutional Framework for natural resources management, and has been improving the collection and analysis of customs data along the southern Sudanese border with Uganda. This activity has been extended to the border with Kenya and will soon be extended to other border areas. Funded by USAID/REDSO and implemented by Department of Agriculture.
