<b>Sanitary-PhytoSanitary Trade Capacity Building Seminars: Congo/Brazzaville</b>	Under the Africa Growth and Opportunities Act (AGOA), the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Foreign Agricultural Services (FAS) Professional Development Program (PDP) will conduct three Sanitary-PhytoSanitary TCB Training Seminars in fiscal years 2004 and 2005. PDP jointly implements this effort with assistance from the USDA, Office of International Trade Policy and, the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Services. The objectives for this initiative are: (1) to focus on issues related to WTO/SPS policy; (2) to conduct SPS risk assessment training; and (3) to generate dialogue between the public and private sectors. Overall the initiative aims to create an environment for dialogue on trade policy implications of the work of SPS international standards setting bodies, and to ensure a better understanding of WTO-consistent approaches to the implementation of food safety and other SPS measures affecting trade.
