Djibouti Regional Livestock Export Processing Facility	USAID, through the Africa Unions International Bureau for Animal Research (AU/IBAR) and the Red Sea Livestock Commission, is financing a regional activity to develop a livestock marketing (export)/health certification facility in Djibouti. Working with associations of livestock producers and herders, a facility will be built outside of Djiboutiville for the large scale holding and health certification of all types of livestock for shipment to the Middle East. The facility will include holding pens, quarantine facilities and modern veterinary services. This is a private sector initiative supported by all the interested countries with the common goal of creating a sustainable, private-sector, market-driven facility that will export over one million head of livestock per year from Djibouti to the Gulf States.
