Combating Child Labor Through Education in Guinea	Provides capacity to governments to adhere to internationally recognized labor standards, including freedom from child labor, which is a requirement for receipt of U.S. trade benefits. Improved Cashew Processing	This activity assists local businesses to learn and invest in the technologies and business practices related to improved processing and sales to both local formal markets and regional markets. It is providing an incentive to producers to by increasing demand for cashews and over the long run should foster increased export of Cashew nuts in all forms. The activity works with many small businesses operated by women. It also fosters purchases from relatively poor cashew producers. This activity is complementary to a Global Development Alliance with Kraft foods, the National Agriculture Research Institute and a local private firm which is designed to increase production and quality of Guinean cashews and foster increased direct exports to the U.S. of processed cashew nuts directly from Guinea.
