Enabling Environment for Exports Improved	Through its partnership with USAID, the Confederation of Mozambican Business Associations (CTA) will continue to lobby for necessary reforms to create a more liberal trade and enabling environment. USAID technical assistance is expected to contribute to the following improvements to the enabling environment in FY 2004: passage of a more liberal telecommunications law; revisions to the decree governing the contracting of foreign labor; approval of a more progressive commercial code; and a reduction of the time required to register companies from 153 days to less than 100. USAID technical assistance and training will enhance the legal environment for private enterprise by expanding the system of alternative dispute resolution established with USAID assistance in FY 2003, thereby improving contract enforceability. USAID, as the donor coordinator in Mozambique for the multilateral Integrated Framework (IF) for Trade-Related Technical Assistance to Least Developed Countries, will assist the Government of Mozambique to complete its application for the second IF round and then expand the USAID-funded Trade Mainstreaming Study to meet the requirements for a full IF "Diagnostic Trade Integration Study."
