Red Sea Livestock Trade Commission Activities in Somaliland	The Red Sea Livestock Trade Commission (LTC) is an autonomous body under the African Union's Inter-African Bureau for Animal Resources (AU-IBAR). LTC, in collaboration with its sister activity, the Pastoral Livelihoods Programme (PLP) of AU-IBAR proposed to work in Somaliland to accomplish the following: (1) facilitate the development, capacity, and effectiveness of Livestock Trade Association; (2) facilitate the establishment of LTC-facilitated livestock export centers in Berbera and the establishment of LTC-accredited private veterinary inspection agencies to certify the livestock status; (3) undertake the necessary quality assurance activities to ensure that all livestock exported are of a high quality and disease free; and (4) support the Government of Somaliland in its efforts to regulate and supervise livestock trade ensuring that only healthy, wholesome livestock and livestock products are exported.
