Donation of Surplus Grain Testing and Inspection Equipment in East Africa	The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) office for International Cooperation Development (ICD), part of the Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS) collaborates with another U.S. agency to donate surplus grain testing and inspection equipment to the Bureau of Standards in three East African countries: Kenya, Uganda and Tanzania. One week of hands-on training and TA was provided in each country to ensure the equipment was properly calibrated and bureau staff are properly trained in operating procedures. The donation of this surplus equipment and subsequent training demonstrates USDA support of the region's efforts towards harmonization of agricultural standards. By supporting the development and harmonization of grain standards and reliable and fast inspection services in these countries, the FAS of the USDA is laying the groundwork for future trade partnerships between U.S. agribusinesses and East Africa. Private Enterprise Support Activities (PESA)	The Private Enterprise Support Activities (PESA) works with small- and medium-sized enterprises, including farms, by providing training and technical assistance to enable them to become more active players in the Tanzanian economy and contribute to its economic growth. PESA works with works with small farmers to produce and market specific cash crops. The work with export crops also includes working on tariff barriers, export procedures, and trade policies of the government of Tanzania. It will help broaden access to markets and strengthen business capacity by encouraging market links, supplying business information, and strengthening associations.
