<b>Djibouti Regional Livestock Export Facility</b>	The Regional Livestock Export Facility in Djibouti is being implemented by the African-Union/Inter-African Bureau of Animal Resources. The objective of the Facility is to certify the health of camels, goats and sheep to be exported from the Horn of Africa countries to importing nations on the Arabian Peninsula. The construction of the facility has advanced over the past year and the facility should be operational in July 2005. The first group of animals has entered the Facility to test the quarantine and health inspection processes. The goal is to be fully operational by the Haj in early 2006. This facility is fully supported by the Djiboutian Government and co-managed by AU-IBAR and the Djibouti Chamber of Commerce. This is a private sector initiative supported by all the interested countries with the common goal of creating a sustainable, private-sector, market-driven facility that will export over one million head of livestock per year from Djibouti to the Gulf States.
