Eurasian American Partnership for Environmentally Sustainable Economies	The principal objectives of this project are: (1) Promoting market-based solutions to environmental problems, with emphasis on the urban and industrial sectors (2) creating lasting environmentally focused partnerships among EE businesses, local governments, and relevant associations and between these organizations and their counterparts in the United States (3) facilitating trade and investment in environmental goods and services and (4) providing access to information for environmental professionals and decision-makers about environmental standards, laws, policies and regulations, environmental technologies, and management systems. Global Initiatives for Proliferation Prevention (GIPP)	The Global Initiatives for Proliferation Prevention (GIPP) program has two elements- the Nuclear Cities Initiative (NCI) and the Initiatives for Proliferation Prevention (IPP)-that advance both U.S. nonproliferation objectives and, as a side effect, trade capacity building in the former Soviet Union. NCI has enjoyed notable success in helping redirect Russian displaced nuclear weapons experts by: (1) developing physical and business infrastructure in the closed cities, (2) helping to establish sustainable enterprises with business plans and marketing, and (3) furthering economic diversification. Two IPP projects in Kazakhstan have resulted in the creation of two new businesses- reprocessing scrap from nuclear fuel manufacture production of copper-beryllium alloy for electronic use) involving U.S., Russian, and European customers, resulting in \$11 million of annual sales and 800-900 new or sustained jobs at this former part of the Soviet nuclear weapons complex.
