Cluster Competitiveness Activity (CCA)	The aim of the Cluster Competitiveness Activity (CCA) is to increase the competitiveness of the wood processing and tourism sectors, and to raise productivity, profits, and employment. The activity helps stakeholders to develop and implement strategies for growth through a combination of technical and financial assistance, facilitation of public-private dialogue aimed at reducing barriers to doing business, strengthening market linkages, and encouraging trade and investment. In particular, the wood-processing sector continues to improve its competitiveness as evident from an increase in exports in 2005 of 10 percent, with exports of value-added wood products increasing by more than 25 percent. The tourism sector has become more competitive, resulting in an increase of more than 18 percent in annual tourism revenue in 2005. Funded and implemented by USAID/Bosnia and Herzegovina. Through discussions, presentations, and meetings an inter-ministerial communication mechanism on WTO issues will be designed in order for the Government of Bosnia-Herzegovina to meet its WTO obligations. Assistance will be provided at all levels of the market chain and includes technical, financial, marketing as well as business and public policy assistance.
