Community Revitalization through Democratic Action - Economy (CRDA-E)	The Community Revitalization through Democratic Action- Economy (CRDA-E) project builds community-level democratic processes and capabilities through partnerships with communities to select and realize hundreds of small to medium-scale development activities in basic infrastructure, environmental improvement, employment and income generation, and civic activities. The project is focuses on activities that stimulate economic development at the municipal and regional level with a focus on agriculture and tourism sectors. For example, CRDA-E is implementing agriculture and wood processing projects that are focused on increasing production and familiarization with export requirements. Tourism initiatives are focusing on projects that impact the creation and promotion of new tourism products, upgrade infrastructure, educate persons employed in the tourism industry for better response to demands of foreign tourists, and improve existing tourism products. Program for Consolidating Economic Policy Reform	<p>The purpose of the Program for Consolidating Economic Policy Reform is to help implement institutional reform and strengthen macroeconomic, fiscal and financial management, and promotion of private sector growth in Montenegro. There are several core areas of strengthening capacity for implementation: (1) fiscal policy, (2) financial sector for bank supervision and commercial bank performance, (3) reform of several key sectors, e.g., labor markets, pensions, (4) commercial law, and (5) additional entities for statistics and entrepreneurship training. There have been several major activity accomplishments: (i) upgraded overall institutional capacity of the Ministry of Finance to respond to policy needs and implement actions, (ii) increased overall institutional capacity at financial sector institutions to address demand and upgrades in international standards, and (iii) supported implementation of commercial legislation needed to ensure sustainable market-based development.
