COTS, operating primarily within the countries of the Organization of Eastern Caribbean States (OECS), has five themes: private sector development, governance, public-private interface, public awareness, and resilience to natural disasters. Technical assistance is targeted at improving the business environment through the updating of business legislation and administrative reform.
